

Jari Villanueva is retired from the United States Air Force where he served 23 years as a trumpeter, drum major, and staff arranger with The United States Air Force Band in Washington, D.C.

During his Air Force career he worked with the chaplains and honor guards at Arlington National Cemetery on thousands of military funerals.

He retired from the State of Maryland after serving 10 years as Director of the Military Funeral Honors program, overseeing the performance of military funeral honors for Maryland veterans.

He now works as a freelance bugler for funerals as well as an officiant for funerals and weddings, and is still serving our veterans as the Veterans Chair for the Governor's Commission on Suicide Prevention and a member of the Governor's Commission for Military Monuments.

Jari is certified to perform funerals, weddings and other services in the State of Maryland. He began officiating at funerals in May 2017.

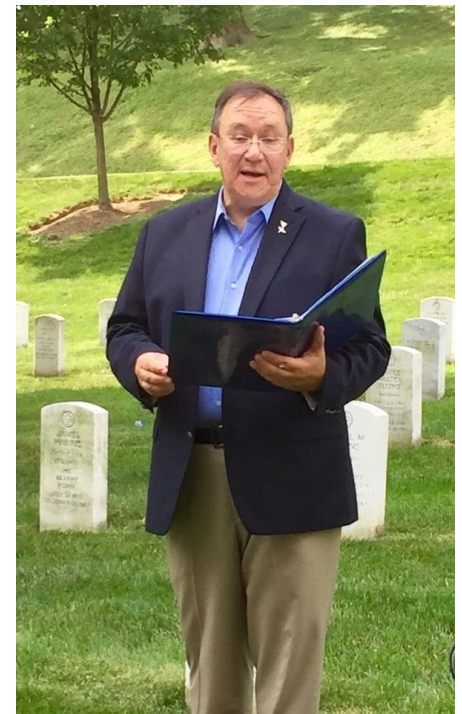
He consults closely with the family in preparation for each service to provide a personalized service geared to the wishes of the deceased.

He is equally comfortable assisting any family with the planning of a small, private ceremony—either military or civilian—honoring and celebrating their loved one's life in the most appropriate way. His 33 years of experience in sounding Taps make this one less thing for a funeral director or a family to have to worry about.
